Hi Brian,

Thanks for sending these over. I input the coordinates you provided in the same order as they're listed and called them points 1-6. Points 1-5 appear close, if not a little conservative. Point 6 appears to be too far east. The coordinates in the excel table in the first email are from the approved application and map and are the defensible coordinates. As long as they align with that, or are a little conservative, you should be good. I'd just consider moving point 6 approximately 27 feet (IF the coordinates provided are accurate). It's possible that the offset is due to you having poor phone service. I'd just go out there and make sure it's aligned with that last tree in the photo.



I attached a KML of your coordinates so you can open them with the other KMLs I sent originally. Also, for future abatements, could you please send the photos attached in an email as opposed to printed, scanned, and emailed? It would just make the photo quality clearer to send it directly -- I can combine it into a PDF for the file.

The Division considers this inspection problem: **abated**.
