Dear Mr. Yocam:

On June 1, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your Annual Report and Annual Map. The Annual fee, map, and report requirements have been met and are current through March 4, 2026. The violation is considered abated, and the above listed permit is now in compliance with C.R.S. 34-32.5-116(3)(a).

Therefore, this notice is to inform you that this matter has been withdrawn from the scheduled June 18, 2025 meeting of the Mined Land Reclamation Board, and you are no longer required to attend this meeting. The Division would like to thank you for your cooperation in the resolution of this matter.

However, because the annual report, map, and fee were submitted after the late submission grace period, **you are still required to pay the civil penalty** for violation number MV-2025-008 in the amount of \$323.00.

To pay the penalty, please:

- make a check out to the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety.
- write "MV-2025-008 for Buffalo Stone Quarry" in the memo line.
- mail the check to DRMS, Room 215, 1001 E 62nd Ave, Denver, CO 80216

Please send the civil penalty payment to the Division **by July 2, 2025.**
