On February 28, 2025 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety concluded its review of the Acreage Release Request application submitted to the Division on November 7, 2024, addressing the following:

Requesting to reduce the permitted area by 80.0 acres.

The decision reached by the Division is: Approve. In accordance with Rule 4.17.2(5), the Division is required to wait thirty (30) days from this notice to allow for appeal of the Division's decision. Once this period closes, if no appeal is submitted, the Division's decision will be final.

The permit area was reduced to 200.00 acres, through the release of -80.00 acres in this permit action. Because the permit is not totally released, you are still liable for filing annual reports and fees. Please submit a Technical Revision and update the mining and reclamation plan maps to depict the reduced permit area.
