Also, please provide a better map that shows all the permit area, clearly and accurately illustrates the area that is the subject of this AR request, and has a scale that can be used with an electronic copy of the map (a scale bar is needed).

You have 30 days from June 4, 2025 to submit all necessary documents that the Division needs for the application to be considered filed. Please submit these by certified mail. If, at the end of the 30-day period, the application has not been determined to be complete and filed, the Division may deny the application and terminate the application file.
