This may include a copy of a lease, deed, abstract of title, a current tax receipt, or a signed statement by the Landowner(s) and acknowledged by a Notary Public stating that the Operator/Applicant has legal right to enter to conduct mining and reclamation.

The agreement must be made between the applicant (Paul and Michael Hampton) and the landowner and mineral rights owner (Weimer Ranches LLLP). A sublease with Gregg Morrill is not adequate.
