Re: West Elk Mine (Permit No. C-1980-007), Technical Revision No. 157 (TR-157), Sylvester Gulch Drainage Modifications

Dear Mr. Munz:

We have received your application for a technical revision to your permit to conduct coal mining in Colorado. Our initial review indicates that all preliminary items required by Rule 2.08.4(5) have not been submitted. Thus, **your application is incomplete for the purposes of filing as of June 13, 2025**. The items that need to be addressed are:

- 1. In the application form, it is not clearly shown if this is a Federal or Non-Federal mine. Please revise that line on the form.
- 2. The application form states that there will be no additional disturbance. However, the ePermitting form for TR-157 states that there will be new disturbance. This apparent discrepancy must be addressed.
- 3. The proposed public notice includes "TR-155" on the first line (rather than "TR-157"). This needs to be revised.
- 4. The TR-157 submittal does not include a revised Map 34 for Locations of Hydrologic Monitoring Stations. Please submit a revised map or explain why this is not necessary.

In accordance with Rule 2.07.3(1), you have the opportunity to amend, review, or otherwise make your application complete.
