Dear Mr. Hamilton,

The Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) is in the process of reviewing the above referenced application in order to ensure that it adequately satisfies the requirements of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Act (Act) and the associated Mineral Rules and Regulations of the Mined Land Reclamation Board for Hard Rock, Metal and Designated Mining Operations (Rules). During review of the material submitted, the Division determined that the following issue(s) of concern shall be adequately addressed before a decision can be rendered.

Section III: Project Description

1. Question 1 states the target commodity as “Poly Metals”, while the Division understands that to be a conglomerate of ore types being investigated, however please specify which Mineral and/or Resource is the main focus of the exploration project.

Section IV: Operation and Reclamation Measures

2. Question 7 identifies the Seed Mix is to be determined by the BLM- Tres Rios Field Office. Recent conversations with the BLM has indicated that a seed mix has been provided to you. Please provide the Division with that seed mix including seeding rates in PLS/Acre. Additionally, please provide the total number of acres intended to be revegetated.

Project Narrative

3. In the access construction section of the narrative, it is described that 3,889 feet of proposed access would be constructed at approximately 12 foot wide. In order to ensure an accurate Reclamation Cost Estimate can be performed, please provide the average depth, or anticipated Cubic Yards of material to be disturbed, and thus replaced, to create and reclaim the access corridors.
4. Also, please clarify if the proposed 60' x' 40' staging area will require any excavation or if it is a pre-existing area that will be utilized.

Please submit your responses to the above listed issues by Monday July 14, 2025 in order to allow sufficient time for review. Written responses should be received by the Division no later than Monday July 14, 2025. If you require additional time please submit a written Extension Request to the Office.
