On June 25, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety concluded its review of the Technical Revision application submitted to the Division on May 29, 2025, addressing the following:

The East Cresson Overburden Storage Area (ECOSA) Long-Term Study Plan focuses on developing a longterm, technically supported, and environmentally responsible strategy to prevent groundwater contamination of Grassy Valley and stop the seeps along the perimeter of the ECOSA.

The decision reached by the Division is: **approve**.

The terms of Technical Revision No. 148 approved by the Division are hereby incorporated into Permit No. M-1980-244. All other conditions and requirements of Permit No. M-1980-244 remain in full force and effect.

Please note that TR-148 was submitted as the long-term corrective action outlining the plan to investigate and develop a permanent long-term strategy to prevent groundwater contamination of Grassy Valley and stop the seeps along the perimeter of the ECOSA, as specified in the Stipulated Agreement for MV-2024-027.
