Technical Revision – Change to Blast Event Notification**

Dear Ms. Carter:

Rocky Mountain Materials & Asphalt, Inc. requests a modification to the Blasting Plan that was approved in TR-03. Specifically, we request that the notification timeline to the adjoining property owner to be 24 hours prior to the blast event. The attached e-mail from Mr. Ken Bishop states that he only needs 24 hours notice. This will allow more precise notification as we monitor site conditions and weather to ensure safe blasting events.

Additionally, our understanding is that DRMS does not require advance notification of blasting events. With this revision, we would remove the requirement to notify DRMS in advance of each blasting event. Blast reports are completed by the Certified Blaster for each event. Those reports are maintained by Rocky Mountain Materials and are available to DRMS upon request.
