Mr. Schleusner,

None of the items identified in the original incompleteness letter have been addressed.

- 1. The documents that you sent to show that you are authorized to act on behalf of the applicant have not been signed.
- 2. BPMS LLC has not been registered with the Colorado Secretary of State
- 3. A permit boundary of less than 10 acres has not been defined
- 4. The application packet does not have the required Exhibits clearly identified

(To elaborate on item 4 for clarity: the permitting requirements for the State of Colorado are distinct from those of the US Forest Service. The Mine Plan of Operations approved by the USFS is necessary to demonstrate that an applicant has legal right of entry to Forest Service land, but cannot simply be duplicated and used in lieu of a correctly formatted Mine Permit Application Packet)

The due date for completeness is July 5, 2025.
