Hi Joel.

Please see the attached inspection report for the Lupton Meadows Mine site. There is one problem noted in the report regarding noxious weeds observed on site. Please conduct weed control in accordance with the approved plan and submit evidence to the Division that it has been completed by the end of June.

You'll need to update the reclamation plan to show the final configuration of the north west pit since the oil and gas well has been removed. Also, the east side needs to be completed soon since mining ended in 2021 and Rule 3.1.3 requires grading, topsoiling and seeding to be completed within five years.

I calculated the bond and determined it is adequate at this time.
