2 110(d) Limited-Impact Reclamation Permit	CO DRMS (this filing)	Pending	Governs all mining & reclamation activities on ≤ 1 acre disturbed land.
3 Colorado General Stormwater Permit for Mining (COR03)	CDPHE – Water Quality Control Division	To be obtained ≥ 30 days before ground disturbance	Required because soil disturbance > 1 acre cumulative over project life is not expected; however, Operator will file “no-exposure” certification unless on-site processing resumes.
4 Air Pollutant Emission Notice (APEN) for portable generator (> 10 hp)	CDPHE – Air Pollution Control Division	To be filed if generator > 5 tpy NOx / PM limits	Small skid-mounted generator presently qualifies as “insignificant activity”; will update if equipment changes.
5 County Road Use / Temporary Use Authorization	Clear Creek County Road & Bridge / Planning	No land use-permit required	No land-use permit required; activity is < 1 acre & < 90 days.
6 State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) clearance	History Colorado	Completed via USFS Section 106 review	No eligible cultural resources affected.
7 Explosives Permit	CO Division of Oil & Public Safety	Not Applicable	No blasting proposed.
8 US Army Corps Section 404 Clean Water Act	USACE, Omaha District	Not Applicable	No wetlands or jurisdictional waters disturbed.
9 Well Permit / Dewatering	CO Division of Water Resources	Not Anticipated	No groundwater interception expected; will apply if needed.
