Please find the Division's response attached.

I note that you asserted in our telephone conversation that while we go through the 110d permitting process your client does not need a Notice of Intent to conduct prospecting (NOI) for activities he intends to carry out at the site. Please be advised that this is true for activity involving hand tools only and affecting <1600 square feet, but for any motorized activity or for an affected area >1600 square feet a NOI would be required.

### Re Ajax 1, File No. M-2025-022 Second Notice of Incompleteness

Dear Mr. Schleusner:

On July 3, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your response to our Notice of Incompleteness for a 110d application for Ajax 1, File No. M-2025-022. The following additional information must be received before the Division can consider your application as being submitted and technical review can begin.

 The Colorado Corporations and Associations Act requires that all businesses that transact business or conduct activities in Colorado must register with the Colorado Secretary of State. Currently there is no record of "BPMS LLC." in the Colorado Secretary of State business entity database. It appears that you have made an attempt to register "Boss project management services LLC", however this name does not match the name used in the application packet.

## Please either register "BPMS LLC." with the Colorado Secretary of State or submit a revised application packet with the exact name of the registered entity used throughout.

2. Please submit a revised application form specifying the **actual permit area** (0.188 acres). Note that all permitted activities must take place within this area.

# Your application will not be considered submitted until all the information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin our review.

The deadline to submit all necessary documents that the Office needs for an application to be considered filed has been extended by an additional thirty days to August 4, 2025. If, at the end of this extended thirty day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with the Office, the Office will deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
