**Re: Incompleteness Notice, Technical Revision No. 1 (TR-1) Update Water Monitoring Plan,  
Ogilvy River Farm Pit, Permit No. M-2024-006**

Mr. Bean:

On July 11, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received the request for Technical Revision no. 1 (TR-1) to revise the water quality monitoring plan for the Ogilvy River Farm Pit, File No. M-2024-0006. Preliminary review of the submittal determined the following item(s) must be received before the Division can consider the revision as being submitted/filed and the technical review can begin.

1. On April 8, 2025, the Division emailed the signed Mined Land Reclamation Board Order (Order), for the new permit application file no. M-2024-006, approving the application over objections. A Certified Mail copy of the Order was delivered to and signed for at the address on file.

The amount of financial warranty set by the Division for this operation is \$163,830.00. You must submit a financial warranty in this amount and a performance warranty in order for us to issue a permit. Please select a type of financial warranty from Rule 4.3 and then contact us so that we can provide you with the appropriate warranty form.

Please note that mining operations and review of TR-1 may not commence until a permit has been issued by the Division after receipt of your financial and performance warranties. A permit cannot be issued until we have verified the adequacy of your financial and performance warranties.

This concludes the Division's adequacy review of your application. The Division reserves the right to further supplement this document with additional adequacy items and/or details as necessary.

The due date for your application is set for **August 13, 2025**. If additional time is needed to respond, an extension request must be received by our Office by the decision date. If on the decision date, outstanding adequacy items remain, and no extension request has been received, your revision may be denied and the file terminated.
