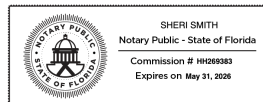

PUBLIC NOTICE

Seneca Property, LLC, 29515 Routt County Road 27, Oak Creek, Colorado 80467, has filed with the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety, a Technical Revision (No. 82) to the Seneca II-W Mine, Permit C-82-057. This technical revision requests monitoring reductions in the hydrologic monitoring plan to end ground water monitoring to allow for well abandonment prior to final release of Mining Permit.

The Seneca II-West Mine is located approximately seven miles south of the Town of Hayden, Colorado, off of Routt County Road 53. The specific area to which this Technical Revision applies is included within the Permit Area located as follows:
