The Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (the Division) received the Deserado Mine's submittal of Minor Revision No. 191 (MR-191) on July 28, 2025. The revision was deemed complete on July 28, 2025. The Division has completed its preliminary adequacy review of the application and has no adequacy concerns. The disturbance for the CH-3 drill hole and access road were already approved under Minor Revision No. 189. The new proposed location will not increase the previously approved amount of disturbance. The Cultural Resource Survey provided with the application package applies to the new proposed location. No impacts to cultural resources will occur under the activities proposed with MR-191.
