COMMENTS

This was a partial inspection by Leigh Simmons of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division). The weather was clear and dry. The status of the Elk Creek Mine is "active" however no coal is being mined and the only activity since the last inspection was site maintenance.

Elk Creek was completely dry.

GENERAL MINE PLAN COMPLIANCE:

The land previously owned by Hotchkiss Ranches has apparently been sold. Oxbow should submit a minor revision to update section 2.03.4 of the PAP and Map 2.03-M1 as soon as possible.

REVEGETATION – Rule 4.15

Vegetative Cover; Timing:

Weed spraying was in progress at the time of the inspection. Curtail, with an added surfactant, was being applied by backpack sprayers on remote reclaimed pads and roads. Vegetation on these areas was generally well developed, with excellent cover and a diverse mixture of perennial grasses, forbs and shrubs, however weeds, particularly Canada thistle, had become quite well established in some spots and a continued effort will be required to control them. Details are given below.




Figure 1: Screenshot of inspection map, showing all reclaimed areas at the Elk Creek \min




Figure 2: Screenshot of inspection map showing only the sites that were inspected






Figure 10: Herbicide (Curtail)
