Your Amendment application for the Tierra Piedra Gravel Pit 110c Construction Materials Reclamation Permit, which is located in Archuleta County has been filed. All comment and review periods began on July 21, 2025. A decision date has been set for August 20, 2025.

Newspaper publication of a notice (published once) regarding the filing of your application and transmittal of a copy of the notice to all owners of record of surface and mineral rights, holders of any recorded easements, and all owners of record of lands that are within 200 feet of the boundary of the affected land is required within 10 days of submittal. You must submit proof of the notice and mailings, such as Certified Mail Return Receipt Requested, to the Division prior to the decision date.

Please be reminded that all operators must contact the Colorado Department of Public Health and Environment, Water Quality Control Division regarding storm water permits.
