AM5 Application Incompleteness Review**

Mr. Alpha,

On July 29, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS/Office) received the 112 Construction Materials Reclamation Permit Amendment Application package for the Hayden Gravel Pit site, File No. M-1987-164. Preliminary review of the information received determined the following items must be received before the Division can consider the application as being submitted and technical review can begin:

Exhibit N – Right of Entry

1. On page N-1 of the application, the applicant states that a copy of the executed lease between the operator and the landowner(s) is provided. This document does not appear to be included within the application package, please provide evidence of right of entry.

Exhibit Q – Proof of Mailing of Notices to Board of County Commissioners and Conservation District

1. On page Q-1 of the application, the applicant does not include proof of notice of the required parties. Please provide receipts from the required parties that demonstrate they have received the required notices.

Exhibit R – Proof of Filing with County Clerk

2. Please see previous comment.

Exhibit S – Permanent Man-Made Structures

3. On page S-1, the applicant states that “proof of delivery of structure agreements is attached to this exhibit.” No receipts appear to have been provided, please resubmit the application with the required notice receipts.

Please be advised the Hayden Gravel Pit application may be deemed inadequate, and the application may be denied on **October 6, 2025**, unless the above-mentioned incompleteness review items are addressed to the satisfaction of the Division.
