has filed an application for construction Materials Limited Impact (110) Reclamation Permit with the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board under provisions of the Colorado Land Reclamation Act for the Extraction of Construction Materials. The proposed mine is known as the Newton Pit, and is located at or near Section 3, Township 1N, Range 46 W of the Prime Meridian.

The proposed date of commencement is August 1, 2025, and the proposed date of completion is August 31, 2037. The proposed future use of the land is pastureland.
