**Re: Adequacy Review No. 1, Technical Revision No. 1 (TR-1) Update Water Monitoring Plan,
Ogilvy River Farm Pit, Permit No. M-2024-006**

Mr. Bean:

On July 11, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received the request for Technical Revision No. 1 (TR-1) to revise the water quality monitoring plan for the Ogilvy River Farm Pit, File No. M-2024-006. On July 14, the Division sent its letter of incompleteness informing the Applicant that the application could not be reviewed until the permit was issued. On August 8, the Division issued the permit for the Ogilvy River Farm Pit. Please be advised that on September 6, 2025, the application for TR-1 may be deemed inadequate and denied unless the following items are addressed to the Division's satisfaction.

1. Please update the analytical data tables to show the date the samples were collected rather than the quarter. See comment #3 below for additional information.
2. The laboratory data reports are incomplete. Please provide the complete laboratory data reports.
3. The laboratory data package labelled as the Third Quarter 2024 is not for the third quarter of 2024. The samples were collected on October 10, 2024, which is in the Fourth Quarter of 2024. It appears that a quarterly sampling event was skipped. Baseline water quality was to be based on 5 consecutive quarters of sampling. Please provide an explanation why a quarter was skipped and its effects on the baseline water quality information for the site.
4. Monitoring wells 2 and 3 are missing an initial quarter of sampling and only have four quarters of data and those quarters are not consecutive. A response is required.
5. The field measurements for the first quarter 2024 sampling event are missing from the tables provided. Please update the table with the missing information.

This concludes the Division's adequacy review of your application. The Division reserves the right to further supplement this document with additional adequacy items and/or details as necessary.



The due date for your application is set for **September 6, 2025**. If additional time is needed to respond, an extension request must be received by our Office by the decision date. If on the decision date, outstanding adequacy items remain, and no extension request has been received, your revision may be denied and the file terminated.
