RE: Dill Pit; File No. M-2009-077; Notice of Incomplete Request for Amendment to Permit for a 112 Construction Materials Reclamation Permit (AM-2)

Mr. Humphries:

On July 31, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division) received your Request for Amendment to Permit for a 112 Permit Application Package (AM-2) for the Dill Pit, assigned File No. M-2009-077. A preliminary review of the information received determined the following items must be received before the Division can consider the amendment as being submitted/filed and technical review can begin:

Application Form:

- 1) According to the Division's records, the total permit acreage for the site is 19.4 acres, including 18.2 acres for mining plus the 1.2 acres for the access road. Please update pages 1 and 4 of the application form to have the correct existing permit acreage of 19.4 acres.
 - a) If the change in acreage will remain at 24.72 acres, then the total should be 44.12 acres. If the operator needs the total acreage to be 42.92 acres, then the change in acreage will be 23.52 acres.
- 2) On page 4, under Description of Amendment or Conversion, please correct the change in acreage (should be 24.72 acres) and the existing acreage (should be 19.4 acres).

Package (Before Exhibits):

- 3) On page 3, the total permit acreage for the site is 19.4 acres, including 18.2 acres for mining plus the 1.2 acres for the access road. Please correct the existing permit acreage to 19.4 acres.
 - a) If the change in acreage will remain at 24.72 acres, then the total should be 44.12 acres. If the operator needs the total acreage to be 42.92 acres, then the change in acreage will be 23.52 acres.

4) On page 82 and 85, the permittee name needs to be Ed and Tracy Grimes, not Grimes Quality Flooring, LLC, dba Yucca Ridge Sand & Gravel. Please correct this prior to posting in the newspaper and sending it to landowners.

The application will not be considered submitted/filed until all completeness items listed above have been received and found sufficient to begin our review. A decision date will be established 90 days from the date of receipt of all required completeness items.

You have sixty (60) days from the date of this letter, by **October 12, 2025**, to submit all necessary information for the application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with our Office, the application will be denied and the file terminated.

This letter shall not be construed to mean there are no other technical deficiencies in the application. The Division will perform an adequacy review of the application to determine whether it meets the requirements of the Act and Rules after all completeness items have been received.
