The Division has received and reviewed the 2025 March and quarterly Discharge Monitoring Reports (DMRs), including the chronic WET testing results for the Trapper Mine. The DMRs were received electronically by the Division on 24 April 2025. Thank you for your timely submittal of this information. Trapper submits DMRs to the Division, in accordance with Rule 4.05.13(2)(a)(iii).

Trapper reported that the following outfalls discharged during the month or during the quarter:

- Johnson #10 NPDES 001
- No Name Pond #5 NPDES 002
- East Pyeatt #2 NPDES 011
- Middle Flume NPDES 020
- East Middle Flume NPDES 021

Trapper reported that none of the outfalls requiring acute or chronic WET testing discharged. DMRs for discharging outfalls indicated no exceedences of paramaters.
