The Division received the attached release notice back in the mail. You should go into ePermitting and update the mailing address for the permittee, 120 85 LLC, to ensure you're receiving all the correspondence for the mine permit.

Just as a reminder, the due date is August 22, 2025 for the corrective actions listed in the inspection report. If you need additional time, send me an extension request and I can give you an additional 30 days to complete the weed control and site maintenance (trash and trailer and vehicle removal). Beyond that, you'll need to complete reclamation to avoid a possible violation.
