On August 25, 2025 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received additional materials for the Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators from Fremont Paving & Redi-Mix, Inc. to Oldcastle SW Group, Inc. dba United Companies, for the Amick Pit, Permit M-1979-103. The following items remain incomplete for the application to be processed:

Legal Right of Enter

1. The lease agreement submitted is between Fremont Paving & Redi Mix, Inc and James and Diana Watson (landowners), is not acceptable.
 - a. Please provide a legal right of entry to the site that is between the current landowner and Oldcastle SW Group, inc. dba United Companies or Oldcastle SW Group, Inc.

Performance Warranty

2. The submitted PW was missing the notary stamp on page 13. This invalids the signatures. Please provide a new PW signed by either Tony Majka or Brandon Pack. (Identified in July 10, 2025, letter from Sara)



Please return the required documentation to the Division **before September 3, 2025**. All completed permit documents are required to be submitted for consideration of your Request for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators Application. An incomplete application may be denied after the 60 day submittal request, if requested documents or information are not received.
