Re: Laster Pit, Permit No. M-2024-005, Amendment Application (AM-1), Notice of Incomplete Application

Dear Mr. Campbell:

On August 13, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (Division/DRMS) received your Amendment application for the Laster Pit, which is located in Sedgwick County. Review of the information received determined that the following additional information must be received before the Division can consider your application complete and the technical review can begin. Thus, your application is incomplete for the purposes of filing as of August 27, 2025.

The Division's review for completeness of this application is based on the specific permit application exhibit requirements for a 112c operation rules detailed in Rule 6.4 of the Construction Materials Rules and Regulations. The Division requires the following incompleteness items to be addressed prior to the application being deemed complete:

1. On page 4, number 16 of the application "Description of Amendment or Conversion", please provide a brief narrative describing the proposed changes in this amendment.
2. The notice sent to the County Commissioners and evidence that it had been received were received by the Division on August 18, 2025. However, we still need evidence that an application was sent to the Conservation District and confirmation that they received it.
3. In the Table of Contents and application Exhibits, the Reclamation Plan is labeled as "Exhibit D", which conflicts with the Mining Plan. Please relabel this Exhibit to "Exhibit E" to be consistent with Rule 6.4.5.
4. Reclamation Costs is also mislabeled in the Table of Contents and application Exhibits as "Exhibit K". Please re-label this to "Exhibit L" to be consistent with Rule 6.4.12.
5. Please be advised that pursuant to Rule 1.6.2(1)(c) and (2), any changes or additions to the application on file in our office must also be reflected in the public review copy, which was placed with the local County Clerk and Recorder.

You may submit your response to these incompleteness items via email, there is no longer a need to mail application materials to the Division.



You have sixty (60) days from August 27, 2025 to submit all necessary documents that the Division needs for the application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty day period, the application has not been determined to be complete and filed, the Division may deny the application.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other technical deficiencies in your application. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submittal of all required items.
