On September 2, 2025 the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety concluded its review of the Technical Revision application submitted to the Division on June 2, 2025, addressing the following:

Update the Mining and Reclamation Maps to reflect updated permit area after acreage release AR-1.

The decision reached by the Division is: Deny. The submittal of the Full/Final Release Request on August 28, 2025, supersedes this TR-2 application.

In accordance with Rule 1.4.11, any person who can demonstrate that they are directly and adversely affected or aggrieved by an action of the Office, may petition for a hearing before the Board on such action within thirty (30) days of the date of the Office decision, if the decision was a denial, without a hearing. Such petitions for a hearing shall state how the petitioner is directly and adversely affected or aggrieved by the Office's decision, and how the petitioner's interests are entitled to protection under the Act. The petitioner shall list and explain any issue the petitioner believes should be considered by the Board at the hearing on the matter. The petition for a hearing shall specify the application or file number assigned by the Office.
