On July 8, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (“Division” or “DRMS”) received your 112c Construction Materials Amendment Application Package for the Alamosa Pit No.2, permit No. M-1983-175. A Notice of Incompleteness was sent by the Division on July 11, 2025, and the Operator provided a response on September 4, 2025. The following information must be received before the Division can consider your application as being submitted and technical review can begin.

Rule 6.4.18- Exhibit R- Proof of Filing with County Clerk and Recorder:

1. In accordance with Rule 1.6.2(1)(c), please demonstrate the response to the initial incompleteness items have been placed with the application materials previously placed with the Alamosa County Clerk & Recorder’s Office and made available for public review.

Your application will not be considered submitted until all the information listed above is received and found sufficient to begin our review.

You have thirty (30) days from the date above to submit all necessary documents that the Division needs for an application to be considered filed. If, at the end of the sixty-day period, the application has not been determined to be filed with the Division, the Division may deny the application and terminate the application file.

This letter shall not be construed to mean that there are no other adequacy deficiencies in the application package. The Division will review your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act after submitting all required items.
