Rio Grande County Road and Bridge, 168 N Washington, Monte Vista, CO 81147 (719)852-4781, has applied to convert M-1987-019, a Limited Impact (110c) to a Regular (112c) Construction Materials Operation with the Colorado Mined Reclamation Board under provisions of the Colorado Land Reclamation Act for the Extraction of Construction Materials to conduct the extraction of construction materials in Rio Grande County. The attached information is being provided to notify you of the location and nature of the proposed operation. The entire application is on file with the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (the "Division") and the Rio Grande County Clerk and Recorder.

The proposed future use of the land is rangeland (State land). Pursuant to §34-32.5-116(4)(m), C.R.S., the Board may confer with the local Board of County Commissioners before approving the post-mining land use. Accordingly, the Board would appreciate your comments on the proposed operation. Please note that, in order to preserve your right to a hearing before the Board on this application, you must submit written comments on the application within ten (10) days after the date of the applicant's newspaper publication.
