RE: Response to Notice of Filing Deficiencies, File No. M-2025-038

Dear Mr. Russell,

I have received your feedback and summary of the filing deficiencies associated with my permit application known as JJ Collecting Project #2 (Redemption) File No. M-2025-038. In this cover letter I will respond to each of these deficiencies below in the same ordered number from your letter (see below):

APPLICATION FORM and GENERAL APPLICATION PROCESS

1. The Applicant/Operator is identified as Jeff Schimel and Crystal Creek Minerals, LLC interchangeably within the application materials. As discussed with Jeff Schimel on August 12, 2025, the intended Applicant/Operator is Crystal Creek Minerals, LLC which matches the Operator (aka Permittee) of JJ Collecting Project #1 Permit No. M-2018-064. Please update the application accordingly; including but not limited to Page 1 – Question 1, Page 2 – Question 9 (*Company Name*), and all of the permit maps.

Response: I have updated the application accordingly. Crystal Creek Minerals, LLC is now listed as the applicant/operator on page 1 (Q 1), page 2 (Q 9), and on all the permit maps. These revised pages are attached to this letter.

2. Responsibility #10 (Page 6) was initialed however, the Applicant/Operator appears to not be a Joint Venture or Partnership. Please revise Page 6 accordingly.

Response: Page 6 has been revised accordingly without my initials and is attached to this letter.

3. Page 7, the Application's Certification, contains two errors which need to be corrected. Similar to Item #1, please update the Applicant/Operator to Crystal Creek Minerals, LLC. Additionally, the notary acknowledgement is missing the year for the date of signature. Please re-execute a corrected Page 7 and resubmit it for the Division's review.

Response: Page 7 (Certification) has been revised accordingly such that the applicant/operator is now listed as Crystal Creek Minerals, LLC and the notary acknowledgment has been redone with the date and year of the signature. The revised page 7 with notary is attached.

4. Photographs of the on-site notice and an affidavit of posting were provided with the application materials, however, please provide either a copy of the on-site notice or a larger/higher-quality photograph so the Division is able to review the posted on-site notice for compliance with the Rules.

Response: I have attached an additional file with larger, higher quality photos so that it can be reviewed for compliance. The new on-site photographs are attached to this letter.

EXHIBIT G – Source of Legal Right to Enter (Rule 6.3.7):

5. Rule 6.3.7 requires documentation to be submitted regarding the Applicant's legal right to enter to conduct mining and reclamation for the surface and subsurface of the affected lands.

A. Within Exhibit G, the Applicant states the owner of the surface is the United States Forest Service and provided a June 13, 2023, letter indicating the Jeff Schimel's Mine Plan of Operations (MPO) is complete for review. Please provide a copy of the conditionally approved or approved MPO from the USFS, which covers the proposed permitted areas to serve as the surface legal right to enter documentation for the DRMS permit. Furthermore, please provide documentation that the Forest Service is aware that the Applicant/Operator for the associated DRMS permit is Crystal Creek Minerals, LLC as their letter states the Operator is Jeff Schimel.

Response: I have received the official conditional MPO approval from the forest service, which acknowledges that Crystal Creek Minerals, LLC is the applicant/operator (not Jeff Schimel) for the associated DRMS permit. This MPO approval from the USDA forest service is attached to this letter.

B. Within Exhibit G, for the subsurface, the Applicant provides Right of Entry agreements between Crystal Creek Minerals, LLC and: (1) Jeff Schimel for *Redemption 1* lode claim CMC 290400, *Redemption 2* lode claim CMC290401, and *Redemption 3* lode claim CMC 290585; and (2) Chris Schimel for *Crystal Road* lode claim CO105786259. Please provide documentation which demonstrates Jeff Schimel and Chris Schimel are the active claimants of the proposed permitted areas.

Response: I have attached PDF documents downloaded from the BLM website showing that Jeff Schimel is the owner of the Redemption 1, 2 & 3 claims and that Chris Schimel is owner of the Crystal Road claim. I have highlighted the appropriate BLM serial numbers of each claim that corresponds with the serial numbers used in my application that refers to these claims. These BLM documents are attached to this letter.

EXHIBIT I – Proof of Filing with County Clerk (Rule 6.3.9):

6. For Exhibit I, the Applicant provided a receipt of certified mailing as proof of filing with the County Clerk and Recorder. In accordance with Rule 6.3.9, please submit an affidavit or receipt indicating the date on which the application was placed with the local County Clerk and Recorder for public review. Rather than a return receipt (aka green signature card) like Exhibit J, this is typically submitted as an affidavit from the County Clerk indicating the application package has been received and put on display for public review. Please provide proof that the original permit application materials are on display at the local County Clerk and Recorder.

Response: I have attached an E-Receipt (letter) from the Park County Clerk confirming that the original permit application has been received by their office and put on file for public review.

7. In accordance with Rule 6.3.9, please submit proof that the revisions associated with this letter have also been placed for public review with the original application at the local County Clerk and Recorder.

Response: The E-Receipt from the Park County Clerk mentioned in query #6 (above) also confirms that the application file has been updated with all the changes and revisions outlined in this letter, with Crystal Creek Minerals, LLC as the applicant/operator.

EXHIBIT J – Proof of Mailing Notices to Board of County Commissioners and Conservation District (Rule 6.3.10):

8. For Exhibit J, the Applicant provided receipts of certified mailing as proof of noticing the local Board of County Commissions and the Soil Conservation District. In accordance with Rule 1.6.2 (1)(a)(ii), please submit Proof of Notice in the form of certified mail return receipts (aka green signature card), e-receipts, or date-stamped copies of the notices acknowledging receipt by the local Board of County Commissions and the Soil Conservation District.

Response: I have attached an E-Receipt from the Park County Soil Conservation District, and another E-Receipt from the Park County Board of Commissioners, each acknowledging they have received my Notice and a copy of the application permit.

Upon application approval and permit issuance, this application becomes a legally binding document. Therefore, there are a number of important requirements which you, as a permittee, should fully understand. These requirements are listed below. 1. Your obligation to reclaim the site is not limited to the amount of the financial warranty. You assume legal liability for all reasonable expenses which the Board or the Office may incur to reclaim the affected lands associated with your mining operation in the event your permit is revoked and financial warranty is forfeited;

2. The Board may suspend or revoke this permit, or assess a civil penalty, upon a finding that the permittee violated the terms or conditions of this permit, the Act, the Mineral Rules and Regulations, or that information contained in the application or your permit misrepresent important material facts;

J.S.

3. If your mining and reclamation operations affect areas beyond the boundaries of an approved permit boundary, substantial civil penalties, to you as permittee can result;

4. Any modification to the approved mining and reclamation plan from those described in your approved application requires you to submit a permit modification and obtain approval from the Board or Office;

5. It is your responsibility to notify the Office of any changes in your address or phone number;

6. Upon permit issuance and prior to beginning on-site mining activity, you must post a sign at the entrance of the mine site, which shall be clearly visible from the access road, with the following information (Rule 3.1.12):

- a. the name of the operator;
- b. a statement that a reclamation permit for the operation has been issued by the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board; and,
- c. the permit number.

7. The boundaries of the permit boundary area must be marked by monuments or other markers that are clearly visible and adequate to delineate such boundaries prior to site disturbance;

8. It is a provision of this permit that the operations will be conducted in accordance with the terms and conditions listed in your application, as well as with the provisions of the Act and the Mineral Rules and Regulations in effect at the time the permit is issued.

9. Annually, on the anniversary date of permit issuance, you must submit an annual fee (\$172), and an annual report which includes a map describing the acreage affected and the acreage reclaimed to date (if there are changes from the previous year), any monitoring required by the Reclamation or Environmental Protection Plans to be submitted annually on the anniversary date of the permit approval. Annual fees are for the previous year a permit is held. For example, a permit with the anniversary date of July 1, 1995, the annual fee is for the period of July 1, 1994 through June 30, 1995. Failure to submit your annual fee and report by the permit anniversary date may result in a civil penalty, revocation of your permit, and forfeiture of your financial warranty. It is your responsibility, as an operator, to continue to pay your annual fee to the Office until the Board releases you from your total reclamation responsibility.

10. For joint venture/partnership operators: the signing representative is authorized to sign this document and a power of attorney (provided by the partner(s)) authorizing the signature of the representative is attached to this application.

NOTE TO COMMENTORS/OBJECTORS:

It is likely there will be additions, changes, and deletions to this document prior to final decision by the Office. Therefore, if you have any comments or concerns you must contact the applicant or the Office prior to the decision date so that you will know what changes may have been made to the application document.

The Office is not allowed to consider comments, unless they are written, and received prior to the end of the public comment period. You should contact the applicant for the final date of the public comment period.

As an authorized representative of the applicant, I hereby certify that the operation described has met the minimum requirements of the following terms and conditions:

1. All necessary approvals from local government have been applied for (Rule 1.6.2(1) and (2));
2. This entire mining operation will not extract more than 70,000 tons of mineral, overburden, or combination thereof in any calendar year (defined in C.R.S. 34-32-110(2)(a));
3. This mining operation will not adversely affect the stability of any significant, valuable and permanent man-made structure(s) located within two hundred (200) feet of the affected lands. (However, where there is an agreement between the applicant/operator and the persons having an interest in the structure that damage to the structure is to be compensated for by the applicant/operator (Section 34-32-115(4)(d), C.R.S. 1984, as amended), then mining may occur within 200 feet. Proof of an agreement must be submitted to the Office prior to the decision date.)
4. No mining operation will be located on lands where such operations are prohibited by law (Section 34-32-115(4)(f), C.R.S. 1984, as amended);
5. As the applicant/operator, I do not have any mining/prospecting operations in this state of Colorado currently in violation of the provisions of the Mined Land Reclamation Act (Section 34-32-120, C.R.S. 1984, as amended) as determined through a Board finding.
6. I understand that statements in the application are being made under penalty of perjury and that false statements made herein are punishable as a Class 1 misdemeanor pursuant to Section 18-8-503, C.R.S. 1984, as amended.

This form has been approved by the Mined Land Reclamation Board pursuant to section 34-32-110(1), C.R.S., of the Mined Land Reclamation Act. Any alteration or modification of this form shall result in voiding any permit issued on the altered or modified form and subject the operator to cease and desist orders and civil penalties for operating without a permit pursuant to section 34-32-123, C.R.S.

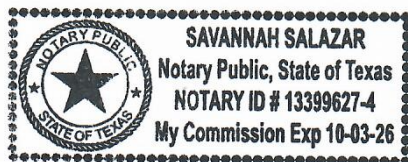

Dear Mr. Jeff Schimel,

I am writing regarding the Redemption Mine Plan of Operations (MPO) (**2810-021210-MPO-2023-001**) for lode exploration and mining related activities on the South Park Ranger District of the Pike National Forest. In my November 21, 2024 letter to you, I informed you that I had signed the Crystal Creek MPO Decision Notice (DN) on November 21, 2024 and instructed you on the final two steps necessary for MPO approval.

I received your Design Criteria, signed by you, the operator, on December 2, 2024, that incorporated into Section IV-A the changes and additions that were identified in the DN. As per the Memorandum of Understanding between the Forest Service and the State of Colorado, Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (DRMS), the DRMS is the lead bond authority and will be responsible for calculating your reclamation bond. This bond will need to be submitted to and approved by DRMS and the Forest Service in accordance with 36 CFR 228.13, prior to the authorization of your MPO. This bond will be used as a guarantee of faithful performance with the terms and conditions listed in the MPO. As a reminder, the bond can be adjusted during the term of the MPO in response to changes in the operations or to changes in the economy. Also, you may request a partial bond release following completion of the ground disturbing activities (i.e., all but monitoring).

These last two steps conclude the stipulations listed in the DN. Therefore, I have conditionally approved your Redemption MPO with my signature in Section IX (attached). Operations are authorized to begin upon receipt of this letter, and are authorized for 10 years, with completion of all activities including reclamation by December 31, 2035.

Please be aware, this approval does not constitute permission to conduct activities that require other agency permits. You are responsible for obtaining all other necessary permits prior to operation. Furthermore, approval of this operating plan in no way authorizes, or in any way permits, a release or threat of a release of hazardous substances or pollutants into the environment that will require a response action or result in the incurrence of response costs.

All designs, monitoring plans, and analyses required by the MPO are subject to the requirement of 36 CFR 228.8 that mining operations be conducted so as, where feasible, to minimize adverse environmental impacts on National Forest surface resources. The operator's compliance with this requirement in no way insulates or releases them from any liability or obligations that may arise with respect to its operations under any applicable environmental law, including but not limited to



the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act (CERCLA), 42 U.S.C. 9601 et seq. The United States reserves its rights and claims under CERCLA to seek performance of response actions and/or reimbursement of response costs that may be incurred as a result of any release or threat of a release of a hazardous substance from the project, or any ancillary operation for the mining activity.

Prior to groundbreaking activities, please contact Geologist Cullen LaPointe to arrange a field meeting to review the final MPO on site.
