SEVERAL PROTECTION AND ENHANCEMENT MEASURES WILL BE INCORPORATED INTO THE OPERATION AND RECLAMATION PLANS TO PROTECT THE CURRENT ACTIVE BALD EAGLE NEST:

\* NO MINING ACTIVITY WILL BE CONDUCTED WITHIN 1/4 MILE OF THE NEST FROM NOVEMBER 15 THROUGH JULY 31.

\* NO MINING ACTIVITY WILL BE CONDUCTED WITHIN 1/4 MILE OF THE NEST THROUGHOUT THE YEAR WITH THE EXCEPTION OF DEVELOPMENT OF AN 12.7± ACRE WETLAND SILT POND CREATED JUST NORTH OF THE RIVER. THE WORK TO CREATE THIS POND WILL BE CONDUCTED OVER A 2 YEAR PERIOD AND WILL BE LIMITED TO AUGUST 15 TO OCTOBER 15 TO PROTECT THE OCCUPIED NEST SITE. A WETLAND BASIN WILL BE CREATED THROUGH MANAGEMENT OF WATER AND PLANTING OF NATIVE WETLAND PLANT SPECIES. THE PURPOSE OF THIS SILT BASIN IS NOT ONLY TO DISPOSE OF SMALLER MATERIALS BUT ALSO TO DEVELOP A WETLAND ADJACENT TO THE RIVER THAT WILL ATTRACT WATERFOWL AND OTHER WILDLIFE SPECIES USED AS A FOOD SOURCE FOR THE EAGLES.

\* THE RIVER CORRIDOR WILL BE PROTECTED FROM ALL MINING ACTIVITY BY A 200 FOOT BUFFER.

\* EXISTING WETLANDS IDENTIFIED IN 2007 WILL NOT BE IMPACTED BY MINING OPERATIONS UNDER THE CURRENT RECLAMATION PLAN. ANY FUTURE CHANGES TO THE RECLAMATION PLAN THAT REQUIRE AN UNAVOIDABLE IMPACT TO JURISDICTIONAL WETLANDS (SUCH AS A ROAD CROSSING) WOULD REQUIRE COORDINATION WITH THE US ARMY CORP OF ENGINEERS AND MAY INVOLVE OBTAINING THE NECESSARY PERMITS UNDER THE CLEAN WATER ACT.

\* COORDINATION WILL BE CONDUCTED ANNUALLY WITH THE COLORADO DIVISION OF WILDLIFE TO MONITOR THE EAGLE NESTING LOCATION AND ACTIVITY. PROTECTION MEASURES WILL BE REVIEWED AND COORDINATED WITH THE COLORADO DIVISION OF WILDLIFE SHOULD THE EAGLES RELOCATE THEIR NEST.

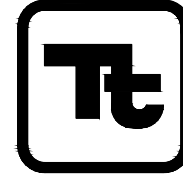
