Re: Inspection Response and Extension Request for Corrective Actions – Permit #M-1999-005

Dear Mr. Girardi,

We are writing to formally request an extension for the corrective actions identified during the August 26, 2025 inspection of our permitted site (Permit #M-1999-005). While we are actively working to address each item, additional time is needed to ensure full compliance and proper documentation. Below is a summary of our progress and justification for the requested extension:

1. Acid and Toxic Materials – Fuel Spill Remediation: We have initiated cleanup efforts and engaged a certified environmental contractor to remediate the impacted soils. Sampling, analysis, clean up and disposal request as detailed in the inspection report has been sent and we are waiting to determine the contractor availability for cleanup and disposal of contaminated materials. Based on their schedule and availability, additional time is required to complete this item. **Requested Extension:** 90 days (New due date: December 22, 2025)

2. Hydrologic Balance – Substitute Water Supply Plan: We have been working diligently with our Water Engineers to complete the SWSP and get approval letters with AGRA and the Colorado Division of Water Resources. Those documents have been attached in the email for your review. **No Requested Extension at this time.**

3. Revegetation – Tamarisk Removal and Weed Control

Similarly, we have requested an environmental contractor to assist with the cleanup of the Tamarisk Weeds and the same time as the material clean up. In the event they are unable to complete this task, we will establish a plan internally for removal and reach out to Otero County as needed. **Requested Extension:** 90 days (New due date: December 22, 2025) at this time.

4. Reclamation Bond – I have requested the Rider increase amending the bond amount to \$639,008.00. Once received and signed, I will be sent to Sara Stevenson-Benn and a copy to you for your records.

Additionally, I will follow up with a confirmation of services as they are established to verify timeline for remediation for both weed control and toxic material remediation. If additional time is required based on contractor availability or other unforeseen impediments, I will reach out again with an additional extension request. We appreciate the Division's oversight and remain committed to full compliance with all regulatory requirements. Please let us know if additional documentation is needed to support this request.
