RE: T.H.E Aggregate Source, Permit No. M-1977-193. Application for Succession of Operator (SO-3); Incompleteness Notice

Dear Mr. Smith,

On October 2, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining, and Safety (Division/DRMS) received the Request for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators application packet (SO-3) for T.H.E. Aggregate Source, Permit No. M-1977-193, located in Fremont County. A review of the information received determined the following items must be received/corrected before the Division can consider the application complete and filed.

1. According to the Fremont County Clerk and Record's, the lands of the permit are owned by Holcim Land Company, Inc. and the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). The documents provided to demonstrate the Prospective Successor's legal right of entry do not appear to be between the current landowner and Amrize West Central Inc. Below is a list of the documents provided, the dates of the documents, and the parties' names. Please provide documentation demonstrating Amrize West Central Inc. and all the landowners for the permitted area.
 - a. Quitclaim Deed; Document date: January 26, 2009; Grantor: POUS, LLC; Grantee: AGGSOURCE, LLC
 - b. Quitclaim Deed; Document date: June 8, 2009; Grantor: Aggsource, LLC; Grantee: Tezak Heavy Equipment Co., Inc.
 - c. Quitclaim Deed; Document date: June 8, 2009; Grantor: Tezak Heavy Equipment Co., Inc.; Grantee: Aggsource, LLC
 - d. Quitclaim Deed; Document date: January 16, 2009; Grantor: Tezak Heavy Equipment Co., Inc.; Grantee: AGGSOURCE, LLC



2. Affidavit of Authority- Please provide an original Affidavit signed by Travis Smith as General Manager of Amrize West Central Inc. and notarized.

This concludes the completeness review for the SO-3 application packet. After the Division receives documents addressing the above issues, a technical review of the SO-3 application shall begin.

You have sixty (60) days from the date of this letter, **December 8, 2025**, to submit all necessary information for the application to be considered filed. If the completeness items identified above have not been addressed by the end of the 60-day deadline, the SO-3 application may be denied.
