Dear Mr. Vezzani:

On December 19, 2025 the Division concluded its review of your Temporary Cessation status request for the WSG-Hribar, further described as:

A request for a second period of Temporary Cessation. The first period began on 10/1/2020 and ended 10/1/2025. **This second period began on 10/1/2025 and will end on 10/1/2030.**

The decision reached by the Division is: **Approve.**

Please be aware that in accordance with Rule 1.13.9, in no case shall Temporary Cessation be continued for more than ten (10) years without terminating the mining operation and fully complying with the Reclamation requirements of the Act and the Rules.

In accordance with Rule 1.13.8, the permit for WSG-Hribar shall continue in effect as long as mining operations resume prior to the end of the second period of temporary cessation.
