Dear Mr. Thurmann:

On January 8, 2025, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received the Application Form for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators from Holcim – WCR, Inc. to Amrize West Central Inc. for the Deer Creek Quarry, Permit M-1997-014. The following items are incomplete for the application to be processed:

Structure Agreement

1. The structure agreement provided does not appear to have been signed by the owner of the structure within 200 feet. Per Rule 6.4.19 please provide one of the following:
 - a. provide a notarized agreement between the applicant and the person(s) having an interest in the structure, that the applicant is to provide compensation for any damage to the structure; or
 - b. where such an agreement cannot be reached, the applicant shall provide an appropriate engineering evaluation that demonstrates that such structure shall not be damaged by activities occurring at the mining operation; or
 - c. where such structure is a utility, the Applicant may supply a notarized letter, on utility letterhead, from the owner(s) of the utility that the mining and reclamation activities, as proposed, will have "no negative effect" on their utility.



Please return the required documentation to the Division **before March 16, 2025**. All completed permit documents are required to be submitted for consideration of your Request for Transfer of Mineral Permit and Succession of Operators Application. An incomplete application may be denied after the 60 day submittal request, if requested documents or information are not received.
