Thank you for your interest in the proposed Red Cliff Coal Mine project. Aspen Avenue, Fruita, Colorado for the purposes of providing information about the proposed project and the environmental review process, hearing statements regarding the fair market value and maximum economic recovery of coal within the proposed Lease by Application area, and to receive comments on the DEIS.
