INSPECTION TOPIC: Signs & Markers

PROBLEM/POSSIBLE VIOLATION: Problem: The mine identification sign was not posted at the entrance of the mine site. This is a problem for failure to post a mine identification sign as required by Section 3.1.12(1) of the rule.

CORRECTIVE ACTIONS: The operator shall, at the entrance of the mine site, post a sign which shall be clearly visible from the access road with the following: the name of the operator, a statement that a reclamation permit for the operation has been issued by the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board; and the permit number. The operator shall submit photo documentation that a proper sign has been posted by the corrective action date.

OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. Jay Wagner, representing the Operator, was present during this inspection. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed during this inspection.

The Wagner Pit is located approximately 1.5 miles southeast of Craig and accessed by a private road from East 1st Street. The site is a 110c operation that includes a total of 8.2 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$10,200.00 for this site.

Adequate mine identification signage was not noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by fencing that was clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

Mining at the site has not yet commenced. However, two wash ponds have been constructed in the west part of the permit area which are used to wash basalt rock extracted from the Wagner Rock site (M-1999-018). A small stock pile of gravel was located in the central part of the permit area.

No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
