OBSERVATIONS

The site consists of an exposed rock wall, approximately 20 feet high, a stockpile of material, some additional surface disturbance and some rubble placed along a slope that leads into the adjacent drainage. No problems were observed during this inspection. The current bond amount is adequate for reclamation.
