#### **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety's (Division) normal monitoring program. Gayle Lyman, representing the Operator, was present during this inspection. Photographs are included with this report in order to illustrate some of the conditions observed during this inspection.

The Gerhman Pit is located approximately 1.8 miles southeast of Craig and accessed through the Bunn Ranch Pit (M-1980-131). The site is a 112c operation that includes a total of 38.33 permitted acres. The Division currently holds a financial warranty amount of \$88,975.00 for this site. The Division has reviewed the reclamation costs for this site, in order to ensure the financial warranty reflects the actual current cost of fulfilling the requirements of the Reclamation Plan, and determined that the current financial warranty amount is sufficient.

Adequate mine identification signage was noted at the entrance to the site.

The affected area was marked by fencing that was clearly visible and adequate to delineate the affected area boundary.

Mining had recently commenced in the Phase 1 area at this site. Much of the Phase 1 pit had been excavated. The west and most of the east banks of the pit in the Phase 1 area were sloped to 3H:1V or flatter. No activity was occurring during this inspection.


No problems or violations were noted during this inspection.
