## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection is a follow up to the March 27th, 2012 Inspection. No operator representative was on site.

During the March inspection the operator was to have completed working on reducing slopes in an area along the west boundary. This was in preparation for submittal of a surety reduction request (SR-01). The work was not complete at the time and the request was deemed incomplete until photo-documentation was submitted showing work was complete for evaluation. The pictures were submitted via e-mail on April 16, 2012.

The slopes are now 2.5:1 or better and acceptable. Material is what may be considered topsoil like for this area.

The site has not been reseeded. This should be done right before monsoon season or in the fall. Seeding must been done by this fall to protect topsoil otherwise reclamation could be hampered significantly.

The operator has had discussions with the local weed control. The inspector has previously noted some knapweed which should be sprayed in a few weeks otherwise reclamation will be compromised.

No other issues are noted.
