WEED MANAGEMENT PLAN

- ① Cut Tamarisk plants and apply
Rodex to cut stems - repeat if necessary - do
not dilute herbicide.
- ② Treat Russian knapweed w/ either of the herbicides below.
(A) Centaury @ 3 qt / Ac
(B) Milestone @ 1 oz / Ac w/ non-ionic surfactant
- * year 1 - ~~May~~ Treat Spring - after elongation / pre flower
may repeat in fall w/ different herbicide if
needed -
- * year 2 - Treat fall w/ milestone Sept - early November
year 3 - Repeat if needed
- ③ Kochia - may need to Treat for Kochia to get seed to set
use ① 24D - before plants 6" tall or use Vista
