Subject: Weed Control Plan

Date: April 26, 2012

Weeds will be controlled in the above named pit primarily by spraying with a broadleaf spray when visible weed growth becomes evident. If conditions become so dry that sprays are ineffective but weed growth continues, areas suitable for disking will be disked. Areas that cannot be disked will be controlled with a large propane field weed burner.

While no grasses have become a weed problem so far, in the event that they do, a glyphosate based spray will be used in combination with the broadleaf spray material.

All tamarisk trees have been removed from this pit at this time.

Please inform me if this plan is inadequate with suggestions for further inclusions.
