This inspection was conducted at part of the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety monitoring program.

Activity at the site is still contained in phase I. There is additional excavation to occur in Phase I to the northwest. The pit run will be spread along the east side of the current excavation sometime this year. Crushing activity occurs at the site yearly.

All disturbance appears to be contained within the permit boundary. No problems were observed during the inspection of the site.


