NATURE OF ISSUE:

On June 8, 2011 Cotter Corporation submitted an Environmental Protection Plan (EPP) for the JD-8 Mine. There remain outstanding review issues that must be addressed that do not allow sufficient time for completion prior to the 365 day limit per Rule 1.4.1(9). The Division and operator agree that an additional sixty (60) days, July 15, 2012, will allow completion of review so a decision can be issued on the EPP submittal.
