## **OBSERVATIONS**

This inspection was conducted as part of the normal program established by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety. The Ellison Pit is located east of Delta, Colorado off of G Road. The site is a 112c-phased operation. Larry Record of Delta County accompanied the inspector during the inspection.

The mine identification sign is in place and in compliance with rule 3.1.12. The sign is located on a post at the main entrance at both mine locations. The permit boundaries are comprised of fence posts that are easily identifiable around the entire perimeter of the mine.

The pit is currently active. Various pieces of excavation, hauling and material processing equipment were observed during the inspection. Adequate amounts of topsoil and overburden appeared to be stockpiled for the approved reclamation plan adjacent to the eastern permit boundary. Stockpiles of processed material were present during the inspection. Current total disturbance at the Ellison Pit is estimated to be approximately 10 acres.

No onsite or offsite stormwater erosion was observed during the inspection.

No problems or possible violations were observed during the inspection.
