SUBJECT: Schwartzwalder Mine Permit M-1977-300 Request for Financial Surety Reduction for Technical Revision No. 18, Notice of Partial Completion

Dear Mr. Kaldenbach:

This letter is requesting a reduction of \$1,406,162 from the total financial warranty covering the subject mine permit currently totaling \$2,843,671.63, thereby leaving a balance of \$1,437,509.63 with the State of Colorado for remaining operational and reclamation costs.

This is a partial bond reduction request for partial completion of reclamation items completed between January 2012 through May 2012, under Technical Revision No. 18. The qualified partial completion of TR-18 consists of the construction and installation of an 18 inch low-flow diversion pipeline. As your records reflect, Cotter Corporation is the owner of the property where the work was performed. Attached is the proposed public notice to be published by the Golden Transcript in Golden, Colorado, which Cotter believes to be the paper of largest circulation in Jefferson County, Colorado. PUBLIC NOTICE

Cotter Corporation, 7800 East Dorado Place #210, Englewood, CO 80111, 720-554-6200, has filed an application for a Partial Release of Financial Warranty with the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Board under provisions of the Colorado Mined Land Reclamation Act. The mine is known as the Schwartzwalder Mine, and is located at or near Section 25, T2S, R71W, 6th PM, Jefferson County, Colorado, approximately five miles northwest of Golden.

The amount of the release application is \$1,480,260.24 for work completed between January 2012 and July 2012; consisting of the construction and installation of an 18 inch low-flow diversion pipeline. The proposed future use of the land is continued reclamation of the mine site.
