Hi Nicole,

I talked to Bill this morning and told him I would try to send a draft version of the bond estimate for the Mica White Conversion. Please be advised this is a DRAFT estimate and conservative. I'm working with Stephanie Carter (BLM) on what the reclamation requirements are for the north slopes. There is considerable variability in the cost associated with that reclamation effort.

The attached pdf files provide the reclamation cost details. Please review them for assumptions and let me know if something is way off.

Finally, as Stephanie and I have talked about what's in the conversion application and what we understood from talking to Aaron on site, there is potentially an issue with BLM right-of-entry. This has to do with the additional ~10 acres of disturbed area at the mine site. As such, there may be an additional adequacy issue. I told Stephanie that I needed to let Colorado Quarries know whether or not this was a potential problem by Friday (5/25/12). She is out of the office tomorrow, so I probably won't know anything until Friday. This may require another extension to the decision date (currently this Friday). Stephanie believes it may take as long as a month to work out the right-of-entry. The DRMS is fine with extending another month. We are nowhere near the 365 day limit.

Please call me if you have any questions about the bond estimate or the right-of-entry issue.
