**RE: Fairview Land Corp.'s desires to retain the La Plata River Bridge at the May Day Idaho Mine Complex after mining is completed**

Dear Randy,

This letter is being provided to Wildcat Mining Corporation (WCM) to confirm Fairview Land Corporation's (FLC) intentions regarding the La Plata River Bridge (bridge) as referenced and described in Technical Revision 3 (TR3) of the May Day Idaho Mine Complex, Permit No. M-1981-185. After the bridge is renovated, as described in TR3, FLC desires to preserve the bridge as a permanent feature of FLC's property. As legal owner of the lands on which the bridge exists, FLC specifically confirms its intention that the bridge not be disassembled, rendered un-useful, or otherwise destructed in the process of complying with DRMS reclamation requirements once mining activities are completed under Permit No. M-1981-185.

I have included with this letter, public notary bearing witness to my signature which serves as legal acknowledgment of FLC's aforementioned intentions.



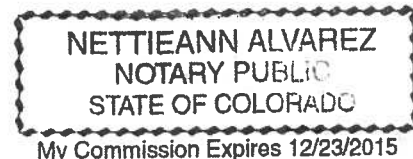
