OBSERVATIONS

This inspection was conducted as part of the normal monitoring program established by the Colorado Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety (DRMS).

This was a partial inspection with the primary focus to observe the locations of the acreage reduction request of the East Middle Fork of Parachute Creek. ExxonMobil has leased the land to Encana Oil and Gas to allow for natural gas drilling and has requested for an Acreage Release of the land observed during the inspection prior to any drilling related disturbances occur. No other components of the mine were inspected on July 10, 2012.

No post-law mine related disturbance has occurred within the East Middle Fork drainage and the only evidence of pre-law mining related disturbance was in the form of revegetative study plots that are from 1972, as indicated on signs that exist within the study plots. The revegetative study plots appear to be spent shale piles due to their dark color. The suspected spent shale piles are completely revegetated with a mature stand of native shrubs and perennial grasses


