On July 23, 2012, the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety received your Hard Rock/Metal Mining Limited Impact 110(2) Reclamation Permit application for the Destiny Mine, which is located in Park County. All comment and review periods began on July 23, 2012. The decision date for your application is scheduled for August 22, 2012.

Newspaper publication of a notice regarding the filing of your application and transmittal of a copy of the notice to all owners of record of surface and mineral rights, holders of recorded easements, and all owners of record of lands that are within 200 feet of the boundary of the affected land is required within 10 days after submittal. You must submit proof of the notice and mailings, such as Certified Mail – Return Receipt Requested, to the Division of Reclamation, Mining and Safety prior to the decision date. Additionally, any changes or additions to the application in our office must also be reflected in the public review copy which has been placed with the Park County Clerk and Recorder.

The Division is reviewing your application to determine whether it is adequate to meet the requirements of the Act. We will contact you if additional information is needed.
